

## Blended Learning Structured Course

### “Structured Educational Visit to Schools & Training Seminars in SPAIN”

Madrid (Spain)

#### WHO is this course for?

Our **Blended Learning Structured course** is best suited for participants who want **greater flexibility** of time, place, and pace, due to personal, professional, or international circumstances.

This structured course is designed for **teachers, head teachers, principals and other school staff** who would like to learn about the Spanish education system within the context of Spanish culture. Although the pedagogic encounters with schools are focused on **Primary, Secondary** and **Vocational** school levels, other educational levels may also benefit from the general approach of this course.

#### COURSE description

This Blended learning structured course combines pedagogic encounters with schools, workshops, seminars, and field projects “Contexts4Content”.

English Matters will select educational institutions related to Primary, Secondary and Vocational levels. Participants will learn about educational organisation and management of learning and will have the opportunity to share their experience and ideas with colleagues from a variety of schools around Europe. This will support a European Dimension in Education and everyone participating in this experience will receive maximum benefit from it.

The course offers several **key activities**:

1. Pedagogic encounters with schools to learn about educational organisation and management of learning.
2. Seminars and workshops to explore specific aspects of the Education System and culture of Spain.
3. Professional and cultural discussion resulting in a concluding presentation of learning.
4. Field projects “Contexts4Content” to explore places of natural, historical, and cultural significance, as a basis for the development of teaching materials to assist their students in meeting their learning goals and be aware of the socio-cultural richness of Europe.

#### Objectives:

- Become familiar with relevant aspects of the Spanish education system.
- Learn about examples of teaching practices in schools in Spain.
- Participate in lectures and workshops related to educational and cultural aspects of Spanish society.
- Participate in field projects “Contexts4Content” to places of natural, historical, and cultural significance, to support the development of teaching resources.
- Promote a European Dimension in education among participants and schools.



## HOW does this Blended Learning Structured course work?

This **Blended Learning Structured course** provides an excellent opportunity to explore the Spanish education system in a gradual way by combining virtual live sessions with a mobility training period in **Spain**.

The course is organised in two segments: during the **virtual segment** you will learn through interactive online live training sessions conducted by tutors and experts. During the **mobility segment**, you will spend an enriching training period in Spain, where you will get first-hand experience of the Spanish education system.

The two segments of this blended course are structured in **three stages**: The efficient combination of these stages will help you build a holistic vision of education and culture in Spain from several enriching perspectives:

- The **1<sup>st</sup> stage** will be implemented during **4 interactive online live training sessions** by video conferencing seminars and workshops with tutors, experts, and course colleagues. This will help you to gain a general understanding of the Spanish education system and its historical and cultural background. To add extra flexibility to your course, you will also have access to our dedicated virtual platform for autonomous learning if you wish to review or expand on content at your own pace.
- The **2<sup>nd</sup> stage** will allow you to enjoy an enriching **4-day mobility training period in Madrid** (Spain), where you will have the opportunity to expand your learning with closer experiences on Spanish Education and school system, as well as following cultural field projects “Contexts4Content” which will also help you to explore Spanish culture while enhancing your communication skills, adding perspective through interaction and dialogue with fellow participants and Spanish people.
- The **3<sup>rd</sup> stage** will conclude the course with a **final online live training session** for presentation of participants’ portfolios, feedback and reflection about the learning achieved, dissemination strategies and European Dimension.

## A NOTE on the Spanish education system

The elegance, passion and history present in the art, literature, architecture, and people of Spain filters through all levels of their culture, including the **Spanish education system**. Spain is always creating, adapting, and looking for inspiration to produce a deep curriculum balancing content, humanity, and variety. The OECD reports highlight the good atmosphere of cordiality in Spanish schools. Spanish students’ sense of belonging is one of the highest among PISA-participating countries. The closeness and friendly relationship between teachers and students, and the commendable work of teachers are key to improving educational achievement. Vocational Training offers enormous quality with excellent plans increasingly oriented to the needs of the present and future labour market. Many Primary and Secondary schools accredit also quality bilingual teaching. Spain is also one of the preferred destinations for foreign students.

## LOCATION of the course: Madrid (SPAIN)

**Madrid** is the second largest city in the European Union and has some of the most visited museums in the world: the Prado Museum, the Reina Sofía National Art Centre, and the Thyssen-Bornemisza National Museum form a wonderful triangle of universal art. The *Barrio de las Letras* (Writers’ Quarter) housed the most famous writers of the Spanish Golden Age (Cervantes, Lope de Vega, Quevedo, Góngora...). In the 20<sup>th</sup> Century, the *Residencia de Estudiantes* brought together and cemented the friendship of the poet Federico García Lorca, the painter Salvador Dalí and the filmmaker Luis Buñuel.
